Purpose: to decrease close contact between people, eliminating masses that could spread the virus. “Essential” businesses remain open and “non-essential” close to support COVID-19 social distancing. *Governor Sisolak Directive on March 17, 2020.*

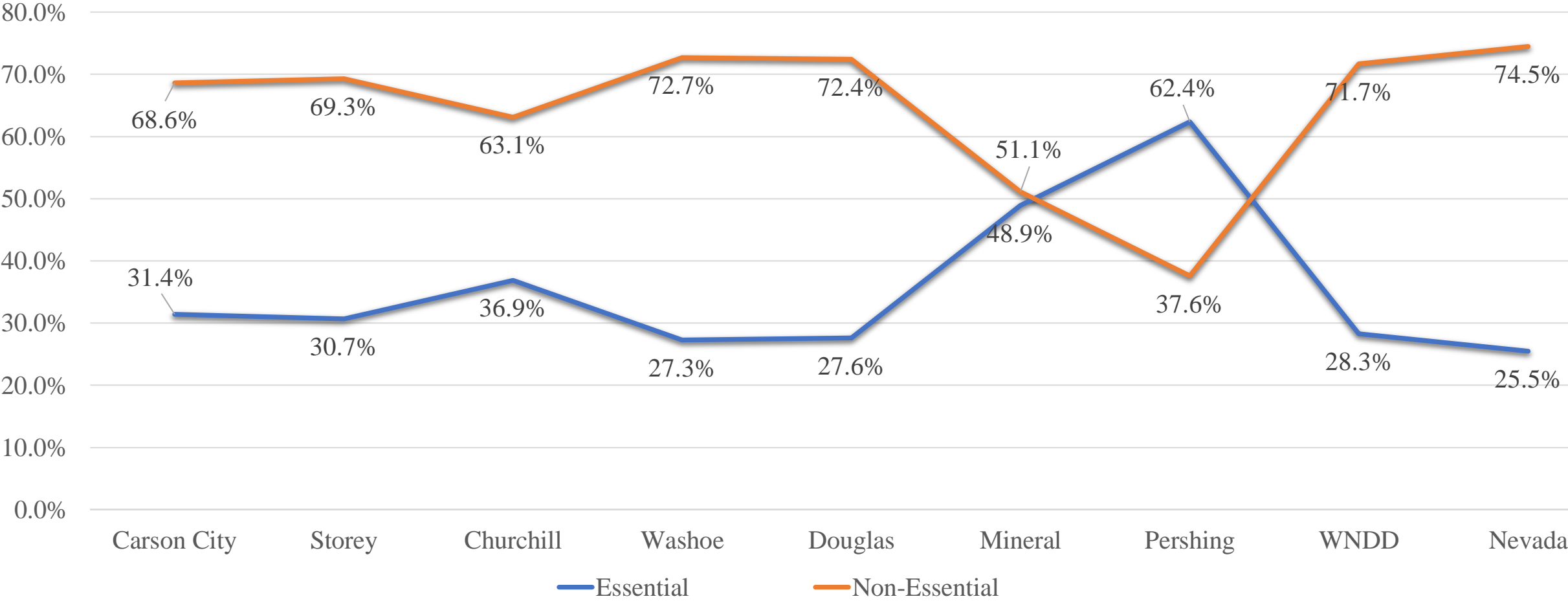
- Essential – businesses that provides products or services that people rely on every day. (Healthcare, utilities, grocery, banks, police, fire, etc.)
- Non-Essential – businesses that people frequent for pleasure like gyms, bars, restaurants, movie theaters, museums, concert halls, casinos, etc.

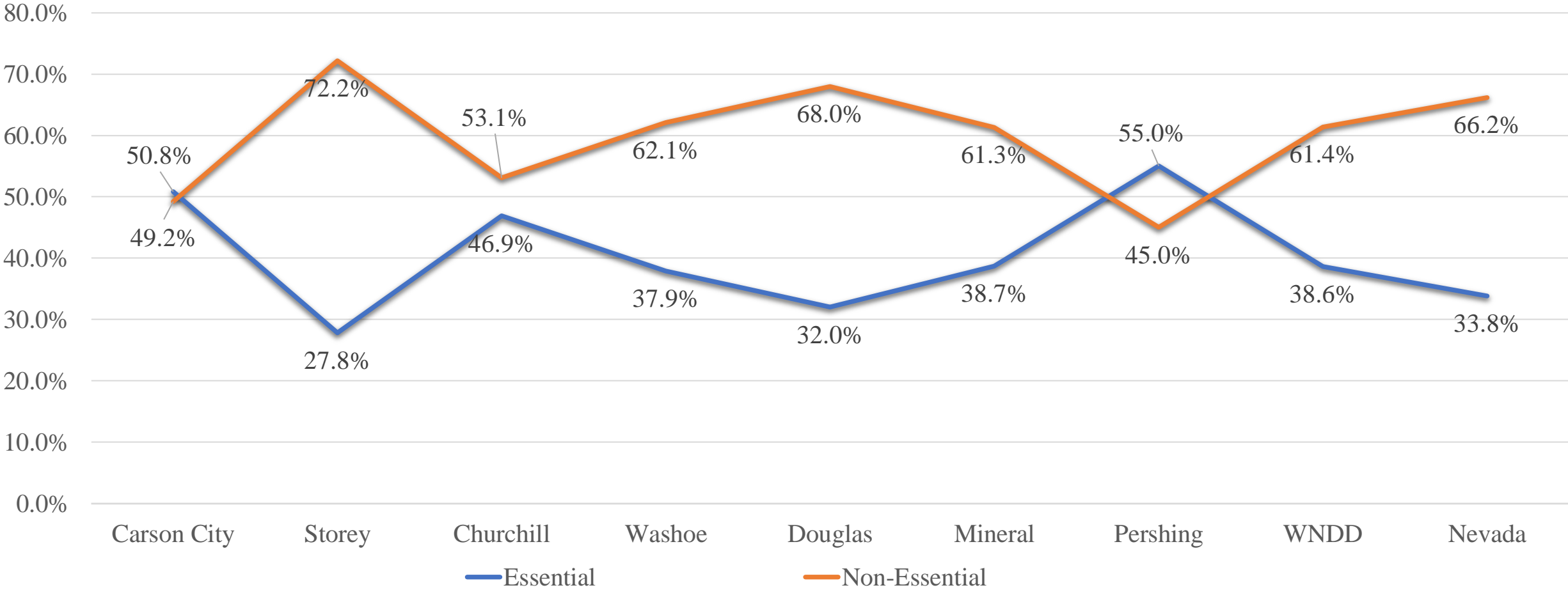

Essential vs. Non-Essential Sectors Businesses



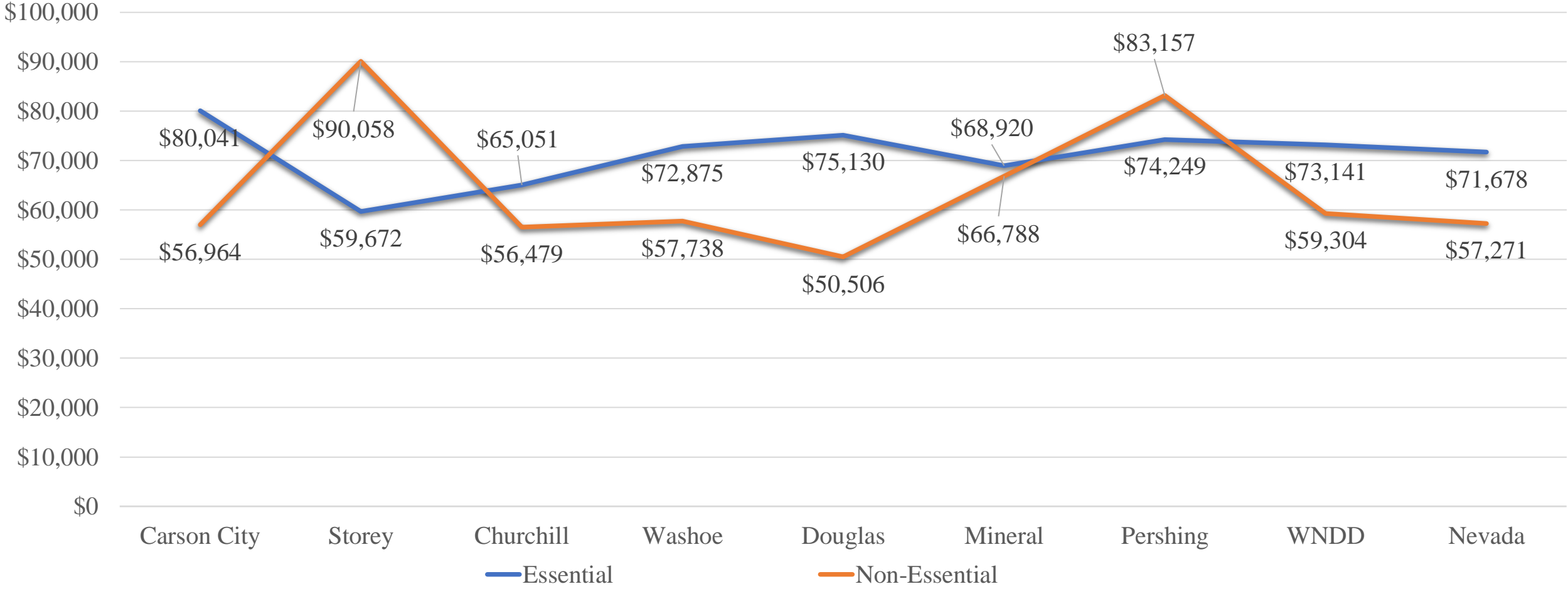
