The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance, or OFA, was created with the passage of Assembly Bill 445 of the 81<sup>st</sup> Legislative Session

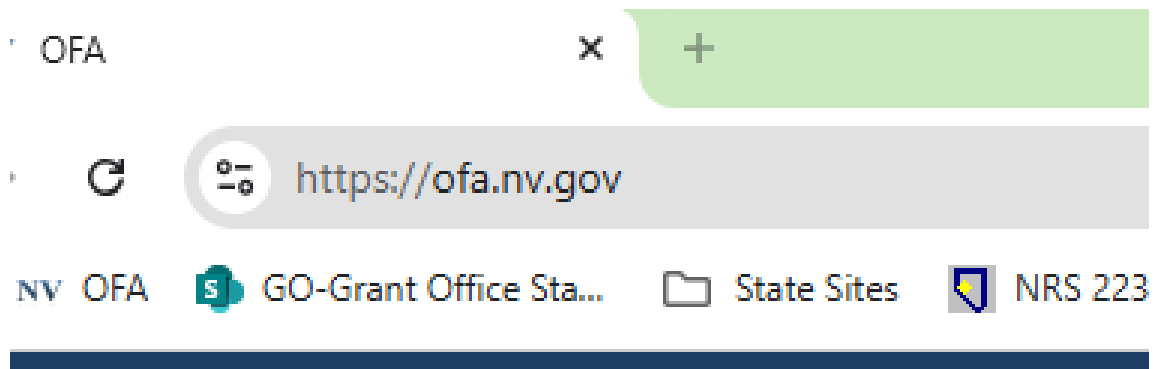
## Vision

## Single Point of Contact (SF-424)

The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance is the federally mandated single point of contact for intergovernmental review (Executive Order 12372).

- ▶ On form SF-424 in federal grant applications (and the grant matching program), you need the State Application Identification Number (SAI#).
- ▶ Using the "Complete a Federal Assistance Notification Form (SPoC & 088-GP 04)" on our home page (3 business days)
- ▶ Benefits
  - ▶ OFA advocates on your behalf with our Congressional delegation
  - ▶ Federal Grant upheavals – We know who is going to be affected
  - ▶ Know who is applying to create partnerships and collaborations



# OFA Overview

The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance (OFA) serves as Nevada's centralized state office for maximizing federal grants and funding opportunities. Our office partners closely with:

# Federal Shifts - What's Happening Now

## **Major Shifts in Federal Funding Priorities**

- ▶ Significant realignment under the current administration
- ▶ Changes affecting eligibility, resource distribution, and reporting requirements

## **Areas Impacted:**

### **Climate Programs Cut**

- ▶ Reduction in EPA environmental justice grants
- ▶ Delays in Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) climate-related rollout

### **Infrastructure Funding Reduced or Reprioritized**

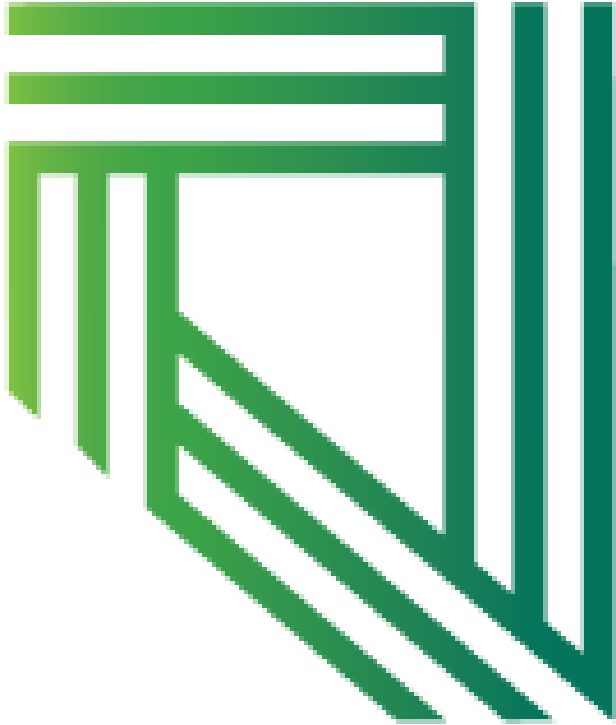
- ▶ Reallocation of funds from broadband and clean energy toward defense or border security
- ▶ Cuts in RAISE and MEGA grants for transportation and transit projects

### **Workforce Development Funding Reductions:**

- ▶ Over \$183 million in funding for Department of Labor programs eliminated in the passage of the CR, limiting resources for training and employment services.

### **Rural Communities Being Impacted:**

- ▶ Delays and cuts in broadband, water, and energy programs have disproportionately affected rural and tribal communities.
